Concha y Toro Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile 2011 <i>(Peterhouse White)</i> <i>Appealing fresh, fruity medium dry white with rich flavours and a clean pleasant finish. Reliable house white from one of Chile's best-known producers.</i>	1
Forge Mill Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa 2011 <i>A refreshing fruit-driven dry white wine made from Chenin Blanc grapes. This wine displays powerful, ripe tropical fruit on both nose and palate.</i>	2
Pinot Grigio, Trefili Casa Vinicola Botter, Italy 2010 <i>A versatile crisp dry white wine with good balanced acidity. Ideal for summer buffets or pre-dinner drinks.</i>	3
Philippe de Rothschild Sauvignon Blanc, Vins de Pays d`Oc 2010 <i>Very much like a good Loire Sauvignon. Intense fruit flavours, prominent acidity, good length on the palate and attractive mineral characteristics.</i>	4
Guinea Fowl, Chenin Viognier, Saxenburg Estate, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2010 <i>A beautifully balanced wine blended from Chenin blanc and Viognier grapes. An ideal match for poultry dishes but also makes for a delightful summer apéritif.</i>	5
Trimbach Riesling Reserve, Alsace 2005 <i>A superb dry Riesling from an exceptional producer. Juicy, vibrant lime flavours with balanced acidity and fine minerality creating a truly classic wine.</i>	6
Sancerre La Clochette, Breton 2009/10 <i>Dry, pure and elegant expression of Sauvignon Blanc. Delightful gooseberry flavours.</i>	7
Chablis Domaine Billaud-Simon 2009 <i>An exceptionally fine, pure and concentrated un-oaked Chardonnay.</i>	8

ROSÉ WINE

Château Guiot Rosé, Costières de Nîmes 2009/10 9

Salmon-pink in colour with finely perfumed aromas, this rich and creamily textured wine with refreshing acidity is perfect for long hot summer days.

RED WINES

Concha y Toro Merlot, Central Valley, Chile 2011 10

(Peterhouse Red)

Youthful and nicely rounded house red from Chile's largest wine producer.

Apaltagua Gran Verano Carmenère, Chile 2010 11

Satisfying flavours and excellent structure are apparent in this wine made from Carmenère, Chile's signature grape variety.

Philippe de Rothschild Pinot Noir, Vins de Pays d'Oc 2010 12

Delightfully vibrant and youthful Pinot Noir with attractive flavours of cherry and spice.

William's Well Shiraz, De Bortoli, Australia 2009 13

A voluptuous mouthful of generous succulent fruit. Cherry blackcurrant flavours.

Camillo de Lellis, Biferno Riserva DOC, Molise, Italy 2006 14

A mature, smooth and complex wine from an obscure Southern Italian wine region. Satisfying and powerful fruit flavours with a lovely velvety finish.

Côtes du Rhône Domaine Grand Nicolet 2009 15

Spicy and full-flavoured wine made from a blend of Grenache and Syrah. Excellent with grilled meats.

Los Vascos Cabernet Sauvignon, Domaines Rothschild, Chile 2008/10 16

Stylish New World Cabernet Sauvignon from Ch Lafite's Chilean operation.

Château Patache d'Aux, Médoc 2003 17

Consistency, excellence and good value are words commonly associated with this outstanding wine produced by the Lapalu family. The 2003 is no exception, displaying delicious ripe, round blackcurrant flavours on the palate.

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE

Freixenet Cordon Negro Brut, Spain NV 18

A traditional Cava made from Xarello, Parellada and Macabeo grapes with a refreshing crisp finish.

Prosecco Spumante Special Cuvée La Delfina, Italy NV 19

A light and refreshing Prosecco with elegant citrus flavours.

Bouvet Brut, Loire NV 20

This outstanding sparkling wine from Saumur in the central Loire valley is made in the same way as Champagne but from Chenin Blanc grapes.

Comte Audoin de Dampierre Grande Cuvée Brut, Champagne NV 21

This exceptional fizz is from the Dampierre family whose champagnes are served in French presidential, ministerial and ambassadorial residences throughout the World.

Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut, Champagne NV 22

An Original Grande Marques est.1825 and still producing outstanding champagne.

DESSERT WINE

Château Septy, Monbazillac (half bottle) 2007 23

Wonderful aromas of marzipan, nuts and melon from botrytis Semillon grapes. Full-bodied and luscious, this wine is ideal by itself or as an accompaniment to desserts.
