<u>WHITE WINES</u>	
Concha y Toro Chardonnay, Central Valley, Chile 2009 <i>(Peterhouse White)</i> <i>Appealing fresh fruity medium dry white with rich flavours and a clean pleasant finish. Reliable house white from one of Chile's best-known producers.</i>	1
Forge Mill Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa 2009 <i>A refreshing fruit-driven dry white wine made from Chenin Blanc grapes. This wine displays powerful, ripe tropical fruit on both nose and palate.</i>	2
Willi Haag Riesling, Mosel-Saar-Ruwer, Germany 2001 <i>Light in body and alcohol this off dry Riesling displays delicate flavours of grapefruit and peach on the palate. Delicious as an apéritif or with fish.</i>	3
Pinot Grigio Terre del Noce Vignetti Delle Dolomiti IGT, Italy 2008 <i>A versatile crisp dry white wine with good balanced acidity. Ideal for summer buffets.</i>	4
Baron Philippe de Rothschild Sauvignon Blanc, Vins de Pays d'Oc 2008 <i>Very much like a good Loire Sauvignon. Intense fruit flavours, prominent acidity, good length on the palate and attractive mineral characteristics.</i>	5
Guinea Fowl Chenin Viognier, Saxenburg Estate, Stellenbosch, South Africa 2008 <i>A beautifully balanced wine blended from Chenin Blanc and Viognier grapes. An ideal match for poultry dishes but also makes for a delightful summer apéritif.</i>	6
Petit Chablis, William Fèvre 2006 <i>Bright, forward Chardonnay fruit set against citrus acidity. Rich and full-bodied.</i>	7
O:TU Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2009 <i>A powerful wine showing intense aromas of passion fruit and gooseberry with a mouth watering balanced acidity. Excellent as an apéritif or with seafood.</i>	8

ROSÉ WINE

- Château Guiot Rosé, Costières de Nîmes 2009** 9
Salmon pink in colour with finely perfumed aromas, this rich and creamily textured wine with refreshing acidity is perfect for long hot summer days.

RED WINES

- Concha y Toro Merlot, Central Valley, Chile 2009** 10
(Peterhouse Red)
Youthful and nicely rounded house red from Chile's largest wine producer.
- Tierra de Luna, Bodega Lurton, Mendoza, Argentina 2009** 11
Syrah and Malbec grapes combine to create a deliciously smooth red.
- William's Well Shiraz, De Bortoli, Australia 2008** 12
A voluptuous mouthful of generous succulent fruit. Chewy blackcurrant flavours.
- Château Lacombe Noailles, Médoc 2003** 13
Deliciously mellow and easy drinking claret. This well-rounded structured red is a perfect accompaniment for red meat.
- Darriaud Réserve, Côtes du Rhône Villages 2007** 14
Spicy and full flavoured wine made from a blend of Grenache and Syrah. Excellent with grilled meats.
- Windy Peak Pinot Noir, De Bortoli, Australia 2008** 15
Delightfully vibrant and youthful Pinot Noir with attractive flavours of cherry and spice. Currently one of the best Pinots from Australia.
- Los Vascos Cabernet Sauvignon, Domaines Rothschild, Chile 2006/7** 16
Stylish New World Cabernet Sauvignon from Ch Lafite's Chilean operation.
- Château Cap de Faugères, Côtes de Castillon 2004** 17
The vineyard from which this wine comes is split between the appellations of the Côtes de Castillon and the more illustrious St Emilion. The character and class of the latter shine through in what is claret of exceptional value and quality.

CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING WINE

Freixenet Cordon Negro Brut, Spain NV 18

A traditional Cava made from Xarello, Parellada and Macabeo grapes with a refreshing crisp finish.

Bouvet Brut, Loire NV 19

This outstanding sparkling wine from Saumur in the central Loire valley is made in the same way as champagne but from Chenin Blanc grapes.

Dubois-Caron Reserve Brut, Champagne NV 20

Clean, fresh and fruity champagne recommended by Jancis Robinson. Made from 50% Pinot Noir, 45% Pinot Meunier and 5% Chardonnay grapes.

Vilmart Grande Reserve Brut, Champagne NV 21

Intense and complex on the nose this champagne is fermented and aged in oak by top grower Laurent Champs. Only 9,000 cases are produced annually.

DESSERT WINE

Château des Tours, Sainte-Croix-du-Mont (half bottle) 22 2003

Wonderful aromas of marzipan, nuts and melon from botrytis Semillon grapes. Full-bodied and luscious, this wine is ideal by itself or as an accompaniment to desserts.
